**TENURE TRACK ACADEMIC CAREER OPPORTUNITIES FROM 2008 TO
2012**

Mount Royal College in Calgary is becoming an undergraduate university. Our own Bachelor of Nursing has received full accreditation and has had its first student intake this September. Many other degrees, including a BA, are slated to commence in Fall 2008.

The Faculty of Arts, which presently comprises 87 faculty in the humanities, social and behavioural sciences and interior design over six departments, will almost double in size between 2008 and 2012 as we roll out our new BAs, adjust workload to a level and balance more commensurate with undergraduate universities, and improve our full-time/part-time ratios. We expect to hire about 20 PhDs in each of those four years in the following disciplines:

Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology/Archaeology, Political Science, Policy Studies, Economics, History, Philosophy, Religious Studies, Women's Studies, Art History, Spanish, French, Linguistics, and English including Film Studies.

The Dean and the Chairs will be visiting your campus on October 15, 2007 and are eager to meet you if you expect to graduate with a doctorate in one of the above disciplines between 2007 and July 2012. We will have with us the latest information about our evolving institution and we can put you on mailing lists to provide updates over the next few years so that we can stay in touch as you move towards completion of your PhD program and we fine-tune our needs for each hiring cycle.

We are excited to be building a different kind of university. Come and find out whether you can see yourself becoming an integral part of our transformation as we near our one-hundredth anniversary in 2011.
