

Background

The President is the senior representative and official spokesperson of the SGPS. The President represents the SGPS to the Board of Trustees, the University Senate, the School of Graduate Studies, and to other officials and bodies both on and off campus.

Responsibilities

- acts as the official spokesperson for the SGPS
- supports the Executive in the performance of their duties and responsibilities
- proposes the direction of policy and other goals for the SGPS to Council
- reports on the actions of the Executive and Officers of the SGPS to Council and the Board of Trustees
- attends meetings of the Board of Trustees, Senate, School of Graduate Studies Executive Committee and such other meetings as may be necessary
- shares oversight of the JDUC and Queen's Centre with the AMS and Student Affairs
- appoints SGPS representatives to various university bodies

Job Requirements

- Candidate must be a member of the SGPS
- Effective communication skills

The President is paid at a rate of \$1,291.66 per month (\$15,500.00 per year).
