

Background

The Vice President Campaigns & Community Affairs (VPCCA) is responsible for representing and communicating the interests of the members of the SGPS at meetings of the external student associations of which the SGPS is a member and generally promoting the interests of SGPS members by making representations to people and organizations external to the University.

Responsibilities

- Work in conjunction with the other members of the Executive and meet on a regular basis at Executive meetings.
- Chair the Campaigns & Community Affairs Standing Committee.
- Attend and report to Council on a monthly basis, as well as at the Annual General Meeting.
- Attend meetings of the CFS.
- Engage with community groups and attend meetings as necessary.
- Attend various other meetings on campus to ensure that SGPS members are effectively represented.
