

Background

The Vice President Professional (VPP) is responsible for representing the SGPS in matters specific to professional students, ensuring that the SGPS as a whole is represented in university affairs at Queen's by making representations to people and organizations internal to the University and for hiring, dismissing, supervising and evaluating SGPS employees (jointly with the Executive Director).

Responsibilities

- Work in conjunction with the other members of the Executive and meet on a regular basis at Executive meetings.
- Chair the Professional Students Standing Committee.
- Appoint members to all relevant University committees.
- Attend and report to Council on a monthly basis, as well as at the Annual General Meeting.
- Maintain a list of SGPS employees and University committee members.
- Attend various other meetings on campus to ensure that SGPS members are effectively represented.

Job Requirements

- Candidate must be a member of the SGPS and a professional student
- Effective communication skills

Remuneration

The VP Professional is paid at a rate of \$1,000.00 per month (\$12,000.00 per year).
